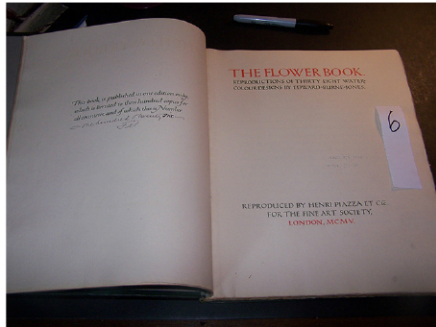
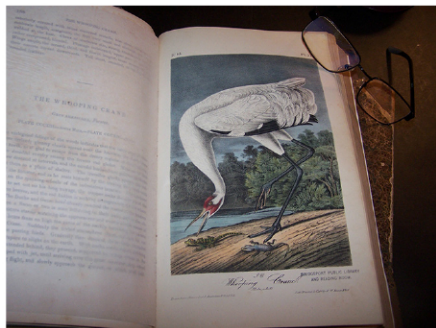
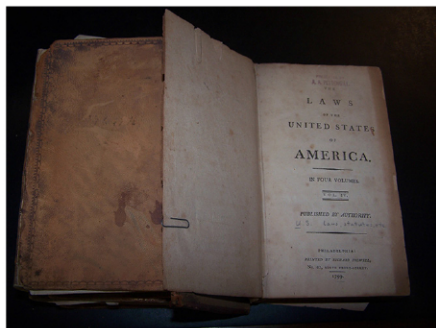
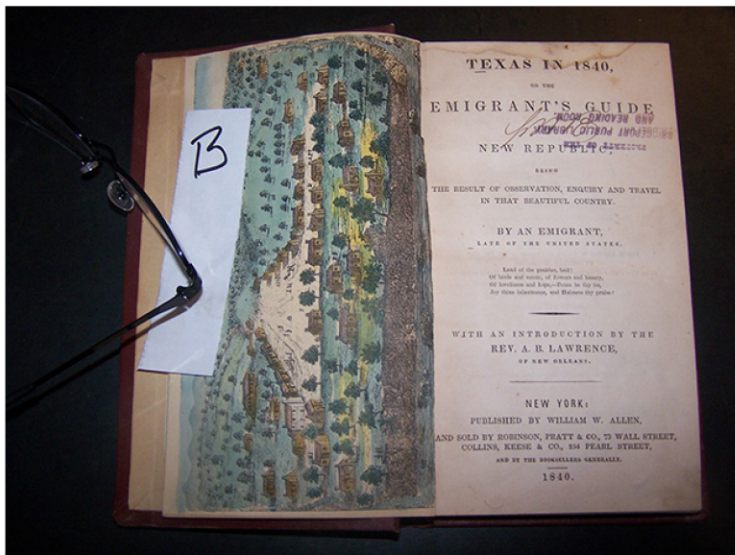
will hold an **ABSENTEE BID AUCTION** on **SEPTEMBER 24 and 25, 2020**

To the art, bibliography, history, children's, exploration and fiction to be offered, this sale has several interesting

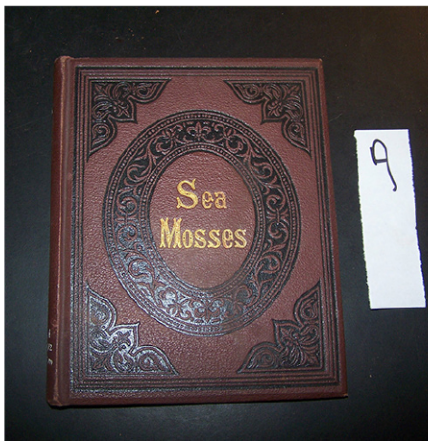
