Nicely upholstered carved wood frame Victorian sofas and settee with matching side chairs, several nice older carved mahogany marble top dressers with mirror frames, 19c Windsor "Arrowback" rocker, 19c oval birdseye maple 3 leg candle stand table, pair of original Chinese Chippendale chairs, Tall pine 18c pine "schoolmaster's" desk with turned legs, large round oak 3 leg coffee tables, 1950's large formal mahogany federal type dining table with leaves and chairs, tall older painted glass mantle clock, pristine federal style drop front desk, intricately carved mahogany double bed headboard and dresser, early 60s solid 8 drawer dresser and writing table, Stickley style original desk, original Saarinen round kitchen table, several old pine drop leaf tables, ma-

hogany bow front china cabinet with lead glass diamonds, many paintings, old frames and framed prints, early wooden tools, Stone tools dated 1777, farm equipment, and folk art pieces, early wooden loom pieces, painted dressers, primitive blanket tall blanket chest (1800's), side tables, original Brunswick working victrola. Major teacup collection, depression glass, Austrian pottery, pair of Don Quixote solid bronze bookends. Also, early radio equipment (circa 1938).
