IMPORTANT ITEMS: Heavily carved 19th century Qing dynasty Chinese fortune chest with cupid crest in arts and crafts period fabric; Beautiful period burl walnut dressing table original brass hardware. This chest measures 23 ½" tall x 40" long x 22 ¼" wide. Five with curled backsplash; Long and narrow Chinese sofa style table; mid-1920s Gustav (5) panels are exquisitely carved with various subject matter. The sellers grandfather Stickley small size corner cabinet with glass doors and folding single drop-leaf on the purchased and shipped this wonderful chest home while visiting China in the mid-1900s; Very unusual, fancy, hand carved and rare, 19th century Austrian 45 drawer cigar humidor closet that stands nearly 6' tall and has a figural carved crest along with to carved panel drawers.
