Collective Hudson is pleased to present an expansive auction featuring an extraordinary selection of fine art, sculpture, Art Nouveau and Art Deco design, French decorative arts, studio glass, lighting, silver, furniture, porcelain, ceramics, clocks, and rare objects of historical interest. This sale brings together a wide-ranging collection of works spanning Old Master, 19th century, Modernist, Art Nouveau, Art Deco, Russian Avant-Garde, American, European, and decorative art traditions, with signed works, attributed pieces, estate discoveries, and important examples of design and craftsmanship. The first portion of the sale will feature approximately 60 lots, many offered without reserve, focused on works from the 60-year collection of a 90-year-old collector, alongside a remarkable group of Russian works discovered in a foreclosed storage unit in Belgium. Highlights include several important works by **Willem de Kooning**, accompanied by COAs and appraisals, as well as works by **Elaine de Kooning**, **Joan Mitchell**, **Richard Diebenkorn**, and a strong **Pablo Picasso** work with provenance.

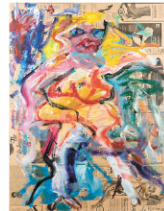

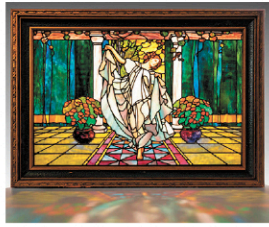

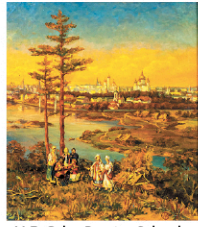
